At WDH there are no pet contracts, weight limits, security deposits, extra fees, etc. And because you are our only guests - no worry your pup(s) might "disturb" other guests.



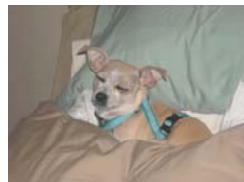
Winnie (NY)

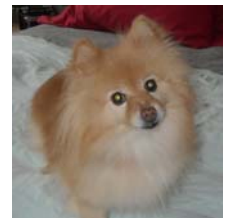

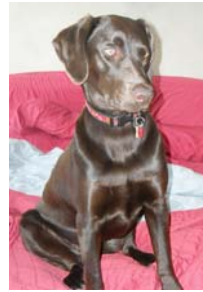
